#### ARTICLE 7 - GOVERNING AUTHORITY

##### SECTION 7.2 - EXECUTIVE BOARD

The Local Executive Board shall consist of the following:

1. President
2. Executive Vice President
3. ~~Vice President~~
4. Secretary
5. Treasurer
6. Executive Board Delegate
7. Executive Board Delegate
8. Executive Board Delegate
9. Executive Board Delegate
10. Executive Board Delegate
11. Executive Board Delegate

#### ARTICLE 9 - LOCAL DELEGATES TO THE C.W.A. NATIONAL CONVENTION

- B. The total number of delegates to the C.W.A. National Convention shall be set by the membership at least thirty (30) days prior to that convention. The first ~~five (5)~~ four (4) delegates to the C.W.A. National Convention shall be the Local Officers. When delegations of less than ~~five (5)~~ four (4) are sent, the Executive Vice President shall be the second delegate; the ~~Vice President~~ Secretary shall be the third delegate; and the ~~Secretary~~ Treasurer shall be the fourth delegate.; ~~and the Treasurer shall be the fifth delegate.~~ For larger delegations, all non-officer delegates shall be elected in the following manner:

#### ARTICLE 13 - LOCAL OFFICER, EXECUTIVE BOARD DELEGATES, CHIEF STEWARDS, STEWARDS AND THEIR DUTIES

##### SECTION 13.1 - LOCAL OFFICERS

- A. The Officers of the Local shall be:
1. President
  2. Executive Vice President
  3. ~~Vice President~~
  4. Secretary
  5. Treasurer

- B. The duties of Local Officers shall be as follows:

~~3. The Vice President shall:~~

- ~~(a) Work under the direction of the Local President; and~~
- ~~(b) Perform whatever duties assigned by the Local Executive Board.~~
- ~~(c) In the absence of the President and Executive Vice President, preside at Local membership meetings, Local Executive Board meetings and may preside at Local Officers meetings.~~
- ~~(d) Attend all Local membership and Executive Board meetings. Three unexcused absences within a year from the above-mentioned meetings, shall be \_\_\_\_\_ considered as abandoning the position and be replaced as provided for in these Bylaws under vacancies in office.~~
- ~~(e) Shall be required to support and carry out all Union programs adopted by the Executive Board and membership. To fail to do so could result in removal from office by the Executive Board subject to the right of the membership to overrule such action.~~

#### ARTICLE 14 - NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS OF LOCAL OFFICERS AND MEMBERS OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD

##### SECTION 14.5 - GENERAL PROVISIONS

- A. The nominees for- President, Executive Vice President, ~~Vice President~~, Secretary, Treasurer and other Executive Board members receiving the plurality of votes cast shall be declared elected. If a tie renders the election indecisive, a run-off will be conducted and the nominees who tied for the position on the first ballot will be the nominees on the second ballot.
